


Focus on: Sequence

This course utilizes the “release conditions” feature of Brightspace modules to guide learners through a specific sequencing of the module activities. The learners can only gain access to content as they complete the requirements of each individual component, in succession.

1 Heavily Structured for a Defined Sequence
“View” weekly checklist is a requirement that learners complete before they can continue forward to the next module content sequence.

2 Setting the stage
Organized around the chapters of the text, this section spells out the learning objectives and context for Chapter 6, and its associated activities.

3 Pre-assessment quiz before the lecture content is released
This formative quiz of the text-reading must be completed before releasing the lecture videos.

4 Instructional Content
By requiring the reading before the lecture video, this course assumes a basic understanding of course content and the lecture expands on that understanding.

5 Graded Homework available upon completion of all module tasks
Accessing homework is dependent on completing all the module activities. When all the required items are complete, the homework/graded activities become available.
